Dear Student,

If you meet the relevant criteria, you may apply for promotion within the Tae Kwon-Do Association of Great Britain via a practical assessment before a grading examiner. This assessment is known as a 'grading'.

If you are deemed to be of the required standard, you will be promoted within the TAGB syllabus and presented with an official certificate and a new belt.

The grading will be held at our Acocks Green TAGB club venue:
Archbishop Ilsey Catholic Technology College, Victoria Rd, Acocks Green, B27 7XY
(School Gym via Shirley Road entrance)

The dojang will be available from 6pm, please endeavour to arrive by 6:15pm.

In order to be considered for promotion, you must have:

- Paid membership fees consistently
- A current TAGB licence which is valid through the grading period
- Attended more than 75% of sessions available
- Completed a grading application form and returned it to your instructor with the external TAGB grading fee of £26 by Tuesday 31st January 2012

The TAGB training manual containing our national syllabus from white belt to black belt is available from your instructor at a cost of £13.
